

S.T.E.A.M. SATURDAYS FAQ

How much does it cost?

The pilot is free. Grant support helps us cover tools, supplies, and staffing so families can participate at no cost.

Do caregivers have to stay?

Yes. A caregiver must remain on-site for the full session.

Is this drop-off?

No. This is a family program. Adults stay and can participate or support as needed.

What ages is this for?

Students ages 6-12. Activities are designed to work across age levels, and we adjust as needed.

What if we can't attend after we register?

Please cancel as soon as you can so another family can take the spot.

Can siblings attend?

Yes, if they are aged 6-12 and each child is registered. Capacity is limited to 20 participants per Saturday.

What if the session is full?

Please email Lucienne Auz at lucienne@metalmuseum.org to join the waitlist. If a spot opens, we'll contact families in order.

Will you take photos?

We may photograph or video the program for education and marketing purposes, but photo permission is optional and chosen during registration.

How do you use family feedback?

This is a pilot, so we'll end each workshop with a short follow-up survey. Feedback helps us refine lesson plans, supply kits, pacing, and accessibility supports before the full program launch.
